



d. Questions of what? and how? are issues, prior to extended understanding.

3. Details of the Spiritual – Revelation and Impartation

a. This area involves the encounter of the Truth with the Holy Spirit. In theological terms this has been called Illumination, but there must be more. Here the Why? and Who? are answered.

b. Wisdom is seeing Truth from God's perspective. Here, Wisdom is born.

c. It is here that the Holy Spirit can quicken and makes a logos to be what some call *rhema*. A koinonia relationship should occur and not another "objective" requirement. (That may well be provided, however) This is at the discretion of the Holy Spirit.

d. The Holy Spirit can impart new "data" or information which must not be considered as having the same authority as Scripture, even though it might relate to Scripture.

4. Details of the Character – Behavior and living out the Truth.

a. Character might appear proper, but if it has not passed through the area of the spirit, it is hypocritical and not born from the truth and only is "religious" or at best, natural.

b. Unless one is a doer of the Truth (Word), deception results. (Ja 1:21-25)

c. The fruits are that which we are known by, and the good works we are ordained to do.

d. The Gospel of the Kingdom is as much about our behavior on earth as our destiny in Heaven.
